## Notes (action items italicized)

- MOU Updates
  - Memorandum of Understanding between agencies (DNR, DFW), County, TNC, and KCT was signed last week
  - This document defines roles, responsibilities, and resource needs on the Cle Elum Ridge and represents strengthened relationships and trust between the entities as they work toward solutions moving forward
  - o CPPC's Role:
    - Community members in CPPC act as a sounding board for MOU signatories and help disseminate information in the community
    - CPPC as community support arm (tabling, talking to legislators and potential funders, rallying broader support for ridge acquisition...)
- Forest Legacy Updates
  - Proposal for \$21 million to acquire all three phases of the ridge (\$15 million federal dollars, the rest through existing RCO grant, a second RCO grant, and community fundraising)
  - o Proposal has complete list of letters of support with County's conditional letter (conditional on MOU) and is getting final touches at DNR

- o DNR will forward letter to Forest Service Regional Office (6), then region sends it to DC office to be reviewed by National Panel
- o Feeling pretty confident about our chances! Can request a copy of proposal from Mitch/Jane once final touches are added
- Other Fundraising Updates
  - o Today is Giving Tuesday: *Share the KCT Facebook post and direct folks to their donation page*
  - o Recent pledges: Two individual donors have pledged \$100,000 each! (\$200,000!!)
  - o Small donor support
    - We have over 100 small donors already
    - Small donations (\$5-20) help demonstrate community support in addition to helping raise funds
    - Still need \$20,000 for Phase I acquisition match, so every dollar counts
  - o Upcoming legislative session
    - Renew efforts for more budget funding for TCF
    - Thanks and support for RCO (last session saw historic funding level)
    - Support amending permitting legislation for DNR and recreational immunity so their process is clarified and makes for easier permitting/events
