- Legislative tours & discussions to date

 - Focus on DNR funding request
 - Currently assembling govt budget
 - Q&A with pitch of what funding request would cover
 - Talked about community engagement and support
 - Very engaged, hard to read degree of support
 - o Budget released: December 15th-19th, might not see until 20th

 - Will talk about management with 5 goals
 - Opportunity to change storyline

 - Will be available in first 2 weeks of January

Funding Update

- Overview of available funding (Phase 1)
 - Just under \$160,000 in our account (\$150k from Suncadia Fund for Community Enhancement, the rest from community fundraising)
 - \$150,000 in a 13 month CD, available in January 2024
 - RCO agreement expires June 20th, 2024
 - Greenway and KCT pursuing major donors to meet the rest of the match
 - TNC working on appraisal of Bambrick for land match
- Future Funding Opportunities
 - Thru IRA and IIJA, several funding streams coming available that could help with O&M and match
 - Forest Legacy funding, \$700 mil thru IRA, 10 year time limit, Forest Service committed to spend it out in next 5 years
 - IFPs come out in April/May, will DNR be ready to apply this year or next year?
 - Potential external partner to help guide thru this process
 - Endowment/private foundation: TNC looking for funds to contract this funding research

- At last OFM meeting, DNR stated they're willing to go below \$2.8 mil, how does this affect their support for future phases?
